Trust Aoraki Ltd is a charitable organisation that administers and distributes funds from gaming machines.

For the 2010-2011 financial year, Trust Aoraki distributed \$850,485 into the local communities from where the funds were generated. This is in the form of financial grants to local sporting and community organisations.

Our philosophy at Trust Aoraki is simple – "locals supporting locals".

100% of available funds raised from our sites are reinvested in the local community. The board and staff of Trust Aoraki continue to be proud to support a wide range of activities in the South Canterbury region and beyond.

A minimum of 37.12% of gaming machine profits is the amount that Department of Internal Affairs requires Trust Aoraki to payout to the community. The actual percentage Trust Aoraki distributed to the community in the 2010/2011 financial

year was 38.63%. Our aim is to ensure that maximum returns are made to the community. A minimum of 70% of the funds distributed goes towards amateur sports and up to 30% of funds distributed goes towards community, health, arts and education.

The Key Business Drivers for Trust Aoraki Ltd are:

- To enhance amateur sport in South Canterbury
- To promote sport, activity and wellbeing
- To add value to the local community by enhancing community and economic development
- To reward excellence and assist where possible

At Trust Aoraki we try and make the process of completing a grant application form easy by either making ourselves available to have a meeting with an applicant or talking through the application process on the phone. We pride ourselves on working closely with community organisations and endeavoring to get the best out of available funds.
